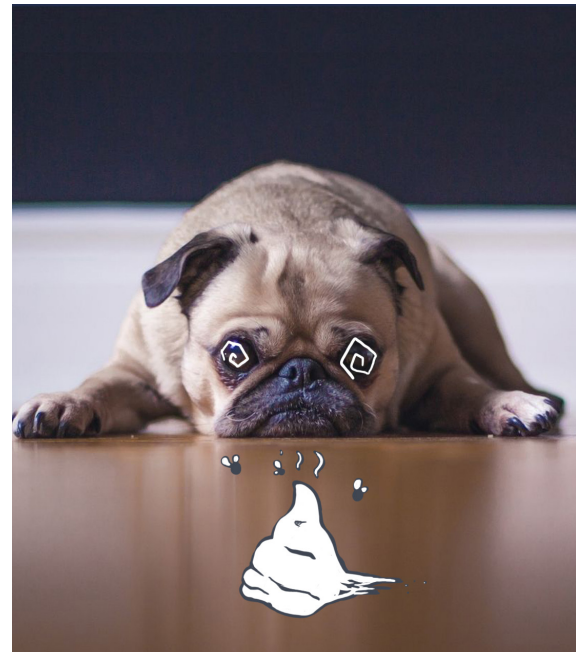
Dog Lovers of Llangattock

The Village Vision gave us good feedback on various doggy matters. We're looking at how other Communities and Town Council's have tried to tackle the perennial problem of dog fouling, we thought it would also be a good time to remind Villagers that the recreation ground is a no dog zone (except for service dogs).

We also have live animals in the Glebe field and whilst

there is a right of way path that is open to all dog walkers, we kindly ask that dogs are kept out of the field to limit the risk to the stock from infectious diseases.

Diseases such as Neosporosis and other parasites found in dog faeces can not only cause abortions and deaths in livestock, it can lead to further infestation between other canids.

County Councillor Jackie Charlton stepped down as a Community councillor last month as the Council welcomed two new Councillors (Chris Jones and Julian Rees). There are still three spaces to bring the Council up to the full complement of 10.
