47/21	<p>Matters Arising from that meeting: Engagement plan: Cllr T Jones Update The Councillors discussed the engagement plan further, research will be ongoing. Shelter's completion: Cllr G Jones Update The sides of the shelters were discussed, Cllr R Jones will liaise with Cllr G Jones with this activity. Cllr T Jones noted that Cllr R Jones has been working non-stop for the Council over the last 10 days. Benches: Cllr G Jones Update The benches are on order from the sub-contractor. Pedestrian Gate: accessibility alterations – Cllr R or T Jones Update Quotes are still outstanding Vehicular Gate: accessibility alterations - Cllr R or T Jones Update Quotes are still outstanding. Goalposts on Football Wall: Cllr A Williams to update Liaising with a younger resident with regards to this, waiting for the response. The structure of the wall is fine for kicking a ball against. Path to tarmac areas: Cllr R or T Jones Update Checking with the sub-contractor. Litter: Cllr H Burns or County Councillor J Charlton to update. Cllr H Burns confirmed that a zoom meeting was held with Keep Wales Tidy and a Powys officer. Keep Wales Tidy have many ideas in relation to litter in the community. The suggestion was to monitor the situation. The Powys officer confirmed that they are moving away from installing new bins.</p>	



	<p>Friends of the Park will be picking monthly on a Monday and Llangattock Litter Pickers will be helping with the sorting so that monitoring can take place. The Friends of the Park will be taking the village from Llangattock Litter Pickers and the flower boxes. Extra bins are still being considered as this would be a cost to the Council.</p> <p>Park Signs: on hold while issues surrounding this are decided A design has been started and are on hold until an appropriate time.</p> <p>Log seating: Awaiting news of felling from Central Services Cllr R Jones confirmed that the quotes are being collated. Cllr A Williams confirmed that she and Cllr G Dobbs will continue to work on a date for moving the logs in the field by the bridge.</p> <p>Toilet pod grant: Update from Finance committee 8th July 2021 Feedback that the Finance Committee agreed with this project, the committee requested that the project be fully funded and was going to be investigated by Cllr S Ady and the Clerk. There had been some in investigation</p> <p>Proposed: Cllr H Burns Seconded: Cllr A Williams Resolved: to approve the application in principle and take to Full Council on the 20th of July, to discuss the need for a contingency and to confirm the figures for the project, with the remainder of the Perk up the Park budget potentially being offered. The maintenance costs to be discussed via this meeting.</p>
48/21	<p>Landfills Path Application: To decide the scope and timeline of the project for the application to proceed. (Please see attached guidance notes for what needs to be included in the application form).</p> <p>Cllr T Jones confirmed that the path has been remeasured there is now a new quote under the £50,000 limit of the Landfill Tax Fund. This costing is based on tarmac. A motion was placed in front of the committee that the preferred option was to do the whole path, if possible, but if this is not possible to phase the path in to 4 phases.</p> <p>Proposed: Cllr A Williams Seconded: Cllr H Burns Resolved: motion passed</p> <p>Whilst the application is currently for tarmac, the committee is researching for eco-surfaces if applicable.</p>
