95/21	<p>To approve the previous minutes of the 11th of January 2022: Proposed: Cllr K Inglis Seconded: Cllr R Jones Resolved: that the minutes are a true and accurate record</p> <p>Matters Arising: All Wales Play Opportunities Grant Update</p> <p>Newsletter and budget report These have been published and received a generally positive reaction – Cllr T Jones</p> <p>Table tennis table has been installed following a site visit by committee members Cllr H Burns & T Jones</p> <p>Gates Work due to start in February, Cllr T Jones will message the contractor for a start date</p> <p>Zipwire Work due to start shortly, now under Central Services, drawings are being checked by a playground expert before the work commences – Cllr R Jones to follow up with the contractor</p> <p>Accessible Picnic Tables The contractor is aware these need to be completed by the end of March - T Jones</p> <p>Ongoing repairs to the climbing frame The contractor is aware this needs to be completed by the end of March - T Jones</p>	

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	<p>Replacement bench – Central Services have ordered one - Cllr Richard Jones to follow up with the Clerk for a delivery date</p> <p>Park Signs: Cllr K Inglis has redesigned this, and the committee decided to order 5 signs @ £25-30 each, one for each entrance. This is less than the sum made available from this committee’s budget.</p> <p>Accessible Toilet Block Concrete has now been laid, waiting for it to dry before installing rails and commissioning the unit. Cllr R Jones and Cllr T Jones. Opening likely early March</p> <p>Log seating update To start in the next few weeks - Clerk or Cllr R Jones. Work in the allotment field is due in the next two weeks and the log seats will be moved into the Recreation Ground as part of that.</p> <p>Football Wall Potential volunteers have been identified to paint football posts and targets on the wall. Cllr Gail Jones will follow up. It is hoped the underspend on signs could be used to pay for paints.</p> <p>Landfill Communities Grant Application Funding update Cllr T Jones updated the committee on the timing of the grant spend for the Recreation Ground path, if approved.</p>
	<p>Other Matters Arising:</p> <p>Platinum Jubilee – update from the working group – Cllr H Burns, Andy Stubbs. The working group is recommending a joint event on June 2nd for the Beacon night with Llangattock Community Council, Llangattock Village Society, and the Rectory Hotel, to be held at the Rectory Hotel.</p> <p>The second event, on Sunday June 5th, could be a community street party held in the Recreation Ground. <i>Motion: The committee voted to allow the serving of alcohol in the Recreation Ground for the celebration of the Platinum Jubilee.</i></p>
96/21	<p>Motion: To decide whether this committee should recommend a standalone public consultation exercise to Full Council to address issues surrounding parking in the village, or whether it should form part of work on a Place Plan.</p> <p>After a debate, the committee decided that the subject of car parking was too important to be rushed and should be a top priority once work consequent on previous and present grant applications was completed.</p> <p>Proposer was Helen Burns Seconded by Andy Stubbs Resolved: passed unanimously</p>
