34/22	<p>To approve the previous Minutes of the 10th of May 2022 Proposed: Cllr H Burns Seconded: Cllr K Inglis Resolved: that the minutes of the 10th May are true and accurate</p> <p>Matters Arising:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Toilet Block: The accessible toilet block is now open. Thank you to Cllr Richard Jones and contractor Land and Stone.• Defibrillator: Cllr H Burns confirmed that she is still awaiting confirmation from the Charity that they will receive a defibrillator.• Jubilee Celebrations: The Council facilitated the Party in the Park at Llangattock Recreation Ground. This was organised entirely by the Llangattock Village Society and was a huge success despite the weather, with much positive comment and interest in making it an annual event.• Recreation Ground Path: Cllr T Jones updated the committee with the information requested from the Contracts Surfaces Working Group. The on-site meeting on the 5th Sunday allowed the committee to delve into the details and a report shared onscreen in relation to the discussion. Heavy use areas were discussed and confirmed and the whole route was measured with the measuring wheel. This information will be passed back to the working group. The questions were:

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Precisely what areas do we think will be the most heavily used and will require the most durable material.• Should we include repairs or replacement of the existing path into the tender• What material should the ramp from the vehicular gates to the tarmac area be made of <p>The committee's recommendation is that the Council tenders for two surfaces: porous bitumen in a mid/light grey colour to match the existing tarmac and grey limestone of a similar shade. Contractors will be asked to quote for the whole path in each material and section by section so that the Council can choose between the two surfaces if costs and usage require a mixed solution. The Motion to be brought to the Full Council will be:</p> <p>That the Council accepts/rejects the recommendation of the Community Committee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Comic Relief grant was confirmed to not be applicable for the kissing gates. <p>26th May 2022 Proposed: Cllr H Burns Seconded: Cllr K Inglis Resolved: that the minutes of the 26th May are true and accurate</p> <p>Matters Arising:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Community Hall Audio Equipment <p>Cllr K Inglis asked when the equipment will be available. 35/22	<p>Grant Funding - New 'Levelling Up' Accessibility Funding administered by Powys County Council:</p> <p>Cllr T Jones confirmed that he and Cllr R Jones have met with officer Stephan Butcher in relation to the new grant that is available via Powys, the deadline is the 20th of June and will run over multiple years.</p> <p>He shared a report that he would like to send to the officer with a view of accessing the grant, the report covers three potential projects that could be approved under the grants remit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Improving the kissing gates on the path between the A4077 and Llangattock Church.• The accessible ramp from the vehicular gates into the Recreation Ground to the tarmac area.• A possible link path from the Recreation Ground to Hillside/Beaufort Road. <p>There will be an opportunity for Council to approve the proposals before they are implemented. The committee were happy for the information to be sent to the Powys Officer at this initial stage.</p>
