74/24	<b>Item:</b> To re-examine the committee structure for the Council and change accordingly Cllr T Jones shared the slides of the previous and the current committee structure of the Community Council. The recent change that led to the Planning and Environment Committee becoming just Planning was discussed, with the Environmental elements being spread amongst the rest of the Council.  Various options were discussed in relation to structure.
